Description of the Defect : Operating or storing Indian Roadmaster models in a wet environment may result in water intrusion into the trunk wiring harness connection. Water intrusion may lead to an electrical short. If not resolved, water could generate corrosion and further damage electrical hardware.

FMVSS 1 : NR

FMVSS 2 : NR

Description of the Safety Risk : Water intrusion into the wiring harness may lead to an electrical short across terminals resulting in constant illumination of the brake light, even if the brakes are not applied.

Description of the Cause : Trunk wiring connections on Indian Roadmaster models were manufactured without plugs that are intended to keep water out of the unused connector terminal ports.

Identification of Any Warning that can Occur : Trunk and fender mounted brake lights or running lights may remain illuminated, even after the vehicle is powered down.

Polaris identified 7 warranty cases in CY 2017 related to water intrusion into the trunk wiring harness connection.

Description of Remedy :

Description of Remedy Program : Polaris will issue a Safety Recall Bulletin with instructions to remove the affected wiring harness and replace with an updated wiring harness that contains plugs in the connectors at no cost to the owner.

If you have had this procedure performed before you received this letter, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall.
