My wife and I own a 2007 GMC Yukon XL. We have 4 children who all ride in the vehicle on a daily basis. I am very upset that GM is working so hard to try to find evidence that the airbag in my vehicle is not "defective". This started in 2016, it has now been 3+ years they have been fighting this (now 2019).

I have download many of the xls files that they have presented as evidence and fear that the data has been manipulated to find in their favor.

When calling GM, their representative told me that the airbags GM sued from Takata were somehow different, better, safer, then all the other ones failing. This statement strikes me as very concerning, and not one I am likely to believe.

If and when myself or a family member dies due to that defective airbag, who will be held personally responsible? Will the explanation from GM be "sorry for that family, must have missed something, but we stand by our data"?

Please hold GM responsible for the parts they installed in our vehicle, that were meant to keep us safe. Please do not let the accounts and lawyers get all the money and the vehicle owners pay with their lives at the benefit of GM's bottom line and share price.
