Description of Defect :

Description of the Defect : It has been decided that the vehicles in the recall population have a Capital two-burner cooktop that the burner flame may be affected during furnace operation.

FMVSS 1 : NR

FMVSS 2 : NR

Description of the Safety Risk : Under certain conditions during furnace operation, the burner flame can invert leading to an increased risk of personal injury, and/or fire.

Description of the Cause : The Capital two burner cooktop is installed in a cabinet that is not entirely sealed from the furnace cavity.

Identification of Any Warning that can Occur : When the furnace is operated it may affect the burner flames causing the cooktop surface to get very hot.

Chronology :

3/4/2019 – Report was made from KZ-RV that a condition may exist that affects the function of the burner when mounted inside of a unit.

3/5/2019 – A model with the Capital two burner cooktop was reviewed to determine if the condition existed in Keystone produced products.

3/6/2019 – Keystone Safety Committee reviewed the information and determined that other models need to be reviewed. Investigation called for to determine affected unit range and model scope.

3/11/2019 – Investigation concluded and scope completed.

Description of Remedy :

Description of Remedy Program : The remedy is to remove the existing cooktop and install a different brand that is not affected in the same manner as the Capital two-burner cooktop.

How Remedy Component Differs from Recalled Component : The different brand of cooktop allows for the same installation without affecting the burner function during use of the furnace.

Identify How/When Recall Condition was Corrected in Production : Units were quarantined, inspected then repaired as indicated by inspection.

Description of Recall Schedule : Keystone will notify the dealers and owners of the recreational vehicles by letter. A final copy of the owner letter will be provided to NHTSA, along with the dealer repair procedures.
