I believe that this rule is long overdue. I drive a fair amount during nighttime hours and have found that certain LED headlights project well above the headlight line. Some of the worst observed are on vehicles manufactured by Acura, especially those that have multiple projecting beams in a horizontal configuration. The light from this array is wide and too tall. Other manufacturer's single beam configurations have better cutoff with a few exceptions.
