As you are aware, GM has petitioned again for relief under the GTM-900 (NHTSA-2016-0124) ie recalls for airbags for multiple GM products. NHTSA has allowed GM more than ample time to provide a remedy. No satisfactory evidence has been provided to date on this now long overdue issue. This has even been showed to be true by your recent IG reports on the lack of NHTSA's oversight of airbag recalls.

Mr. Scovell you are certainly aware good people are put in danger ever day on our roads. We have a government agency who has singular cognizance and fiduciary responsibility to provide oversight for consumer safety. Many people have died, some I suspect were warriors, some even marines sir.
